


Create your own Liturgical Lacing Cards



Materials needed: plywood boards, sandpaper, drill, wood finish, pencil, ruler; modpodge, large paintbrush, icons printed on paper (3x4"), paint pens; symbols printed on paper (3x4"), pencil, tacky glue, sand, paint pens; colored laces, scissors, hot glue gun, "jewels"



Prep the boards

- 1. Cut boards \sim 6" x 8"
- 2. Sand edges
- 3. Use a ruler to measure ½ "border from each edge, mark with thin pencil line
- 4. Use pencil to mark light spots for holes all along the border, $\sim \frac{1}{2}$ " apart (or you can skip this step and just "eye-ball" it.)
- 5. Use a drill to drill holes. I found I could easily stack & drill 3 boards at one time. Drill in. Reverse drill out.
- 6. Sand back and front of board to eliminate splinters.
- 7. Spray (or paint) back and front of board with finish.

Decorate the FRONT of the board

- 1. Cut out/trim seasonal icons (printed from computer on regular paper). Icons should be no larger than 3"x4"
- 2. Use a large paintbrush to paint a thin layer of modpodge over the FRONT of the board.
- 3. Carefully position icon over the board, press down onto the modpodge.
- 4. Spread a thin layer of modpodge over the top of the icon.
- 5. Allow to dry.
- 6. Use paint pens to label, decorate, embellish, illuminate, illustrate the space surrounding the icon.

Decorate the BACK of the board

- 1. Cut out a square of paper (\sim 3" x 4") on which is printed a Christian symbol.
- 2. Use a pencil to shade the BACK of the paper
- 3. Center the square of paper on the BACK of the board, with the symbol facing up.
- 4. Use a pencil to trace the symbol.
- 5. Remove the paper (there should be a faint outline of the symbol remaining on the board.)
- 6. Use a thin paintbrush to paint the symbol on the board with glue.
- 7. Cover the glue with sand, then dump off excess sand.
- 8. Allow to dry.
- 9. Use gold or silver paint pens to outline symbol.

Add laces

- 1. Cut 2-4 laces per card \sim 3' long each.
- 2. On the back of the card (sand/symbol side): Anchor 1-2 laces in upper left hand corner of the card. Anchor another 1-2 laces in lower right hand corner of the card.
- 3. Anchor the ends of the lace to the board using hot glue. Use a "jewel" to cover and press down the lace into the hot glue and board. (You could also just anchor the ends with a knot, but I think the glue/jewel thing looks neater.)
